This three-day event aims to facilitate sharing of expertise and experience between the UK and Indonesian education institutions, government agencies, ELT companies. It is focused on innovation, best practice and enhancing the quality of English language teacher training, teaching and learning. It also seeks to promote UK ELT expertise to wider Indonesian audience.
